



SAMPLE ITINERARY

Grand Canyon Hermit Trail 4 Day Tour:

Day 1 - We pick you up from your hotel and drive to the Hermit Trailhead on the South Rim. We will hike the same day, approximately 10 miles to Monument Creek, descending 3,200 feet. This will be our camp for the first night.

Day 2 - We will take a side hike today to the Colorado River at Granite Rapids and then move our camp over to another set of rapids along the river, Hermit Rapids. The hike is 5.3 miles with a relatively small elevation change.

Day 3 - We pack up and hike to the Hermit Creek Campsite. Here we can explore the remains of the old Hermit Camp from the 1920s or cool off under the small waterfalls in Hermit Creek. This is a laid back day and we will only have to hike 1.5 miles.

Day 4 - We will pack up early and then proceed to hike out of the canyon along the same trail in which we came. This will be a long day and the hike usually takes between 7 and 8 hours to complete.
