



SAMPLE ITINERARY

Havasupai 3 and 4 Day Tour:

Day 1 - We will pick you up and travel to the trailhead at Hualapai Hilltop. Once we arrive, we will hike 10 miles to the campground from the trailhead and descend 2,100 feet. The hike to the campground takes about 5 hours.

Day 2 - We will spend the day exploring the three waterfalls in the area, Havasu, Mooney and Navajo. We may also head into the village of Supai for a lunch of Indian Tacos.
Total hiking distance: 5 to 7 miles.

Day 3 - We will hike 10 miles out of the canyon, ascending 2,100 feet.

Optional – We can also extend this tour to four days. The four-day tour is essentially run the same as the three-day tour, but on day two we hike downstream from Mooney Falls to the remote Beaver Falls. We have to cross the Havasu Creek 3 times (sometimes in thigh deep water) before we get to the falls. You don't see as many people on this section and sometimes we are fortunate enough to spot some big horn sheep.

On the third day we will hike around Havasu and Navajo Falls and then back to the village of Supai. On the fourth day we hike out of the canyon and head back to civilization.
