



Indian Garden 2 Day Tour

The Havasupai Tribe once inhabited the area that is now known as Indian Garden and when you arrive you will see why they once called this place home. This is the easiest backpacking trip we offer in Grand Canyon National Park but you will not be disappointed! It is also the perfect trip for the hot summer months or for families with younger children. And, if you don't want to carry all of your camping gear to the bottom of the Grand Canyon, Indian Garden allows us to set up a base camp about 3,000 ft (914m) below the rim.

Day 1

We will pick you up from Phoenix or Flagstaff and travel to the canyon (4 hours from Phoenix and 1.5 hours from Flagstaff). Upon arriving at the canyon, we will hike down the Bright Angel Trail to Indian Gardens where we will camp for the night. We drop about 3,000 ft (914m) over 4.5 miles (7.24km) and the hike usually takes about 2.5 to 3 hours to complete. After dropping packs and storing food, the group then hikes to the Colorado River along the Bright Angel Trail and back before dinner. This hike to the river is an additional 6.2 miles with a 1,400 ft drop in elevation to the river. This is a tough day but we have gotten people to the river and back before by following this route.

Day 2

We pack up camp and hike out the way we hiked into the canyon along the Bright Angel Trail. The distance is 4.5 miles (7.24km), climbing 3,000 feet (914.4m) in elevation over that distance. Once at the top, we set aside time for the group to have lunch and souvenir shop before we drive you back to Phoenix or Flagstaff and complete your journey. The average time to hike out is between 4 and 5 hours.

Cost

\$650 per person from Phoenix (4:30 am pickup)
\$600 per person from Flagstaff (7:15 am pickup)
